



Droit Privacy Statement

24th May 2018

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This Privacy Statement relates to your information in connection with your use of Droit services or enquiries to Droit via our websites (including droit.tech and all subdomains) or other communication mediums, and also to other offline services, and activities undertaken by Droit.

This Privacy Statement, which may be updated from time to time, contains information about the collection, processing, and legal basis for the handling of your data. This Privacy Statement outlines Droit's security, access and data retention practices. This Privacy Statement also contains information about your rights under GDPR.

1. Information we collect

In order for Droit to provide services, we need to collect and process certain information. Depending on your interaction with Droit that may include any of the following:

Information you provide by using Droit products or completing forms on Droit websites; including your name, email and postal addresses, telephone number, login, and password details. We may ask for this information if you register as a user of Droit services or if you contact us;

Communications you send to us (for example, when you ask for support, send us questions or comments, report a problem, or apply for jobs);

Information about the ways people visit and interact with our websites, in the form of traffic analytics.

Droit uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google Inc. (1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA; "Google"). Google Analytics uses cookies that are stored on your computer and facilitate the analysis of your use of our websites and online features. For further information please visit <https://support.google.com/analytics/answer/6004245?hl=en>. You can opt out of being included in Google Analytics here at <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>.

Droit also uses AWS CloudFront, a content delivery network of Amazon Web Services, Inc. (1200 12th Avenue South, Suite 1200, Seattle, WA 98144, USA; "Amazon Web Services"). CloudFront is used to host Droit's webservices and collects aggregated user information such as operating system and browsers. For more information please visit <https://aws.amazon.com/privacy/>.

Cookies:

Droit uses cookies to enable you to browse our websites and use our online features as a logged in user and to remember any preferences that you have set for the site whilst you are

on our site. If you disable cookies in your web browser, certain features of our site may not be available.

We also collect information from certain organisations, where appropriate, and in the legitimate course of our business, including business directories, corporate events, social media sites or where you are referred to us by another individual.

2. Where your information is processed

Droit both operates and utilises sub-processors across global locations therefore information will be shared across those locations in the legitimate course of our business. When sharing information, we will make sure your information is properly protected.

3. How we use your information

We use the information you provide in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Statement. If you provide information for a certain reason, we may use the information in connection with the reason for which it was provided. For instance, if you contact us by email, we will use the information you provide to answer your question or resolve your problem. Also, if you provide information in order to obtain access to the services Droit provides, we will use your information to provide you with access to such services and to monitor your use of such services. Droit may also use aggregated information collected through your use of these services to help us improve the content and functionality of the services, to better understand our users and to improve the services.

4. Our legal basis for processing your information

The laws in some jurisdictions require companies to tell you about the legal ground they rely on to use or disclose your personal data. To the extent those laws apply, our legal grounds are as follows:

Contractual commitments:

Much of our processing of personal data is to meet our contractual obligations to our users, or to take steps at users' request in anticipation of entering into a contract with them. For example, we handle personal data on this basis to create your account and provide Droit services.

Legitimate interests:

In many cases, we handle personal data on the ground that it furthers our legitimate interests in ways that are not overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the affected individuals which includes but is not limited to:

- Providing a safe and enjoyable user experience;
- Customer service;
- Business development;

- Protecting our users, personnel, and property;
- Analysing and improving our business;
- Processing job applications;
- Managing legal issues.

Legal compliance:

We need to use and disclose personal data in certain ways to comply with our legal obligations.

Consent:

Where required by law, and in some other cases, we handle personal data on the basis of your implied or express consent.

5. Security of your information

Droit takes commercially reasonable technical, administrative and physical security measures designed to protect your information from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

Communications over the internet (such as emails) aren't secure unless they have been encrypted. Your communications may go through a number of countries before being delivered as is the nature of the internet. We cannot accept responsibility for any unauthorised access or loss of personal information that is beyond our control.

6. How your information is shared

Droit entities may share your information between themselves in order to provide Droit services or in the case of other legitimate reasons as outlined by this Policy Statement. Individuals within Droit will only have access to information that is required for them to perform their roll within the firm.

Droit may share your information with certain trusted third-party services to help us provide, improve, or protect Droit's services. When we share data with third-party services that support the delivery of Droit's services, we require that they use your information only for the purposes we've authorized, and that they protect your personal information at least to the same standards we do. We may also share information that's aggregated and anonymized in a way that it doesn't directly identify you.

Droit reserves the right to disclose personal information when we believe that doing so is reasonably necessary to comply with the law or law enforcement, to prevent fraud or abuse, or to protect Droit's legal rights, property, or the safety of Droit, its employees, users, or others.

7. Data retention

We generally retain personal data for so long as it may be relevant to the purposes identified within this Policy Statement. To dispose of personal data, we may anonymize it, delete it or take other appropriate steps. Data may persist in copies made for backup and business continuity purposes for additional time.

8. International information transfers

We may need to transfer your information to other Droit entities or service providers in countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA). This kind of data transfer may happen if our servers or our suppliers and service providers are based outside of the EEA, or if you use our services and products in countries outside this area.

9. Links to other websites

This Privacy Statement applies only to the products and services that Droit provides or websites that Droit operates. These services and websites may contain links to other websites not operated or controlled by Droit. The policies and procedures described in this Policy Statement do not apply to these third-party sites. Any links from Droit websites or services do not imply that we endorse or have reviewed the third-party sites or their policies. We suggest contacting those sites directly for information on their privacy policies.

10. Your rights

Individuals of certain jurisdictions may have certain legal rights to obtain confirmation of whether we hold personal data about them, to access personal data we hold about them (including, in some cases, in portable form), and to obtain its correction, update, amendment or deletion in appropriate circumstances. They may also object to our uses or disclosures of personal data, to request a restriction on its processing, or withdraw any consent, though such actions typically will not have retroactive effect. They also will not affect our ability to continue processing data in lawful ways.
